FEED THE LEGO MONSTER: DUPLO SORTING GAME

Have you ever tried this LEGO monster feeding game with your child? With some LEGO® DUPLO® bricks of assorted colours and a little DIY craft, you'll have endless fun with this activity. The game is a great way for children to learn numbers, colours and shapes. Playing this exciting game also helps children to improve their fine motor skills and ability to concentrate on simple tasks.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:



Brown Paper Bags



Sheets of coloured paper



Pair of scissors



A pencil



Googly eyes & pipe cleaners



LEGO DUPLO bricks in various colours

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



1

Draw your monster shape on a piece of coloured paper

Make the monster as scary as you like! Make the mouths of the monsters different shapes so your child can learn to differentiate between them.



2

Mark out the shape of the monster mouth on the paper bag using a pencil, then cut out the mouth

You can use child-safe scissors if your child would like to help. Scissor use is great for working on fine motor skills.



3

Get your child to glue the monster to the front of the bag and decorate with more details

Googly eyes are a great way to talk about numbers while you play: "Can you feed these bricks to the monster with three eyes?"



4

Make a variety of different coloured monsters and start the game!

Open up the bags and let your child feed the matching colour LEGO® DUPLO® bricks into each monster's mouth. Combine colour and number skills by asking your child to feed three red bricks to the monster with three eyes (for example). For an even trickier fine motor challenge, try cutting smaller-shaped mouths for the monsters. Make sure to ask what noises the monsters will make!
